
WHEREAS said portion of right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes; and

REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Highways Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the abandonment of a portion of the right of way acquired for State Route Business 40 within the above referenced project. This portion was previously established by the Arizona Highway Commission resolution dated September 9, 1927, page 26 of the official minutes as U S Route 66; thereafter, the Arizona Transportation Board Resolution 84-10-A-65 dated October 26, 1984, redesignated as State Route Business 40.

A portion of the previously acquired right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes. The City of Williams has agreed to accept jurisdiction of the right of way. Accordingly, I recommend that the State's interest in the portion of right of way be abandoned.

The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on the maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Highways Division, Phoenix, Arizona.

I further recommend that the portion of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" be abandoned to the City of Williams.

Those rights of way and easements and appurtenances thereto subject to the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-1903 shall continue as they existed prior to the disposal of right of way depicted in Appendix "A".

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-1864, I recommend that the Transportation Board adopt a resolution making this recommendation effective.
