
WHEREAS said portion of right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes; and

REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Highways Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the abandonment of a portion of the right of way acquired for old U S 66, now a portion of Business Route 40. within the above referenced project. This portion was previously established by the Arizona Highway Commission resolution dated September 9, 1927, page 26 of the official minutes, establishing U S 66 as a state highway. Resolution 63-71, dated November 8, 1963, improved and re-established SR B40.

A portion of the previously acquired right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes. Coconino County has agreed to accept jurisdiction of the right of way. Accordingly, I recommend that the State's interest in the portion of right of way be abandoned.

The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on the maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Highways Division, Phoenix, Arizona.

I further recommend that the portion of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" be abandoned to Coconino County.

Those rights of way and easements and appurtenances thereto subject to the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-1903 shall continue as they existed prior to the disposal of right of way depicted in Appendix "A".
