RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

LARRY S. BONINE, Director, Arizona Department of Transportation, on October 17, 1997, presented and filed with this Transportation Board his written report under Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7046, recommending the abandonment of State Route 84 within the above referenced project.

The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, CASA GRANDE - TUCSON Highway, Project 084PN177H088801R / 010PN232H088801R."

WHEREAS said portion of right of way is no longer needed for state highway purposes; and

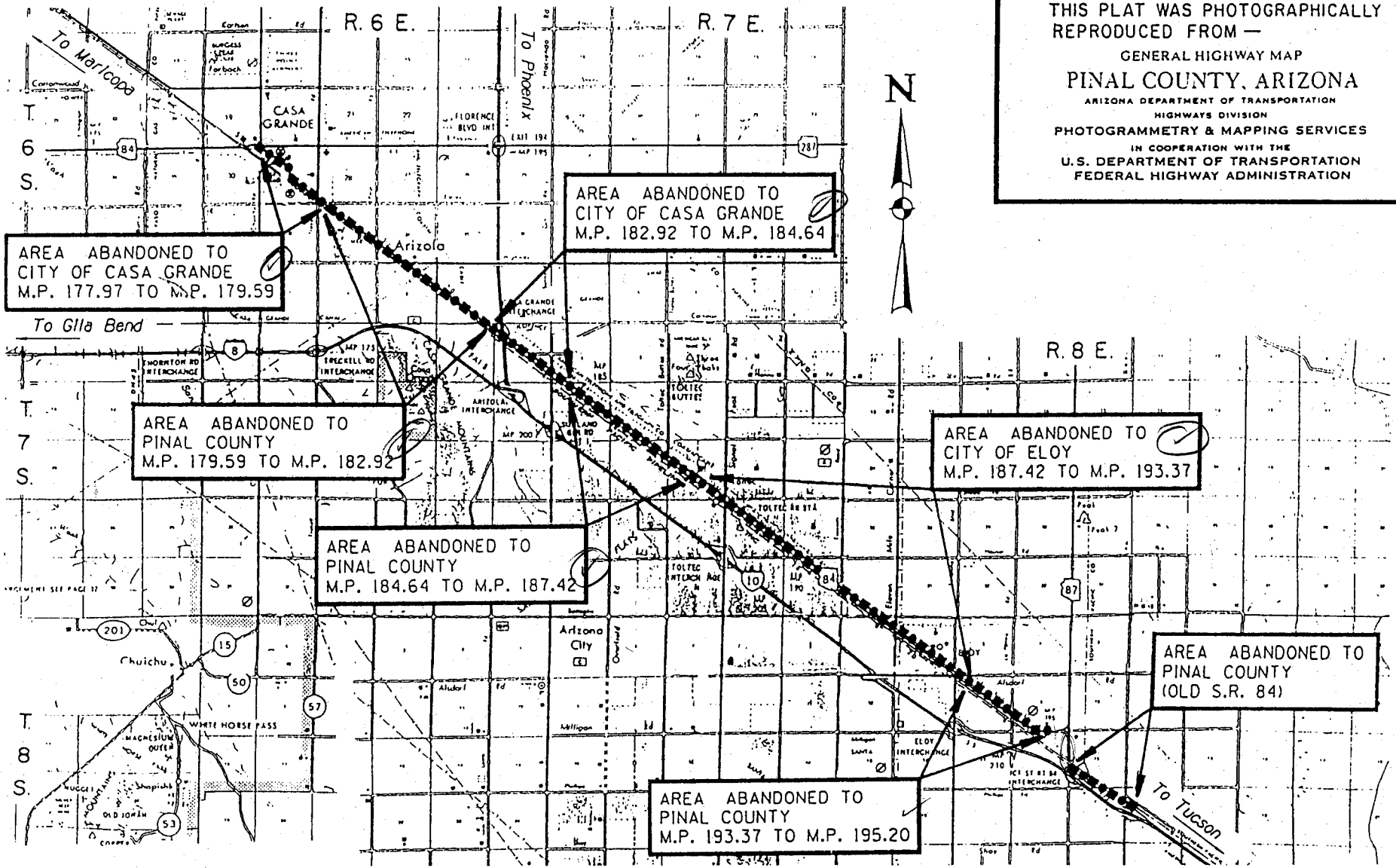
WHEREAS this Board finds that public safety, necessity and convenience will be served by accepting the Director's report; therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the recommendation of the Director is adopted and made part of this resolution; be it further

RESOLVED that the portion of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" is hereby removed from the State highway system and abandoned to the Cities of Casa Grande, Eloy and Pinal County, as it falls within their jurisdiction, as provided in Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7207 and 28-7209; be it further

RESOLVED that the Director provide written notice to the Cities of Casa Grande, Eloy & Pinal County, evidencing the abandonment the State's interest.

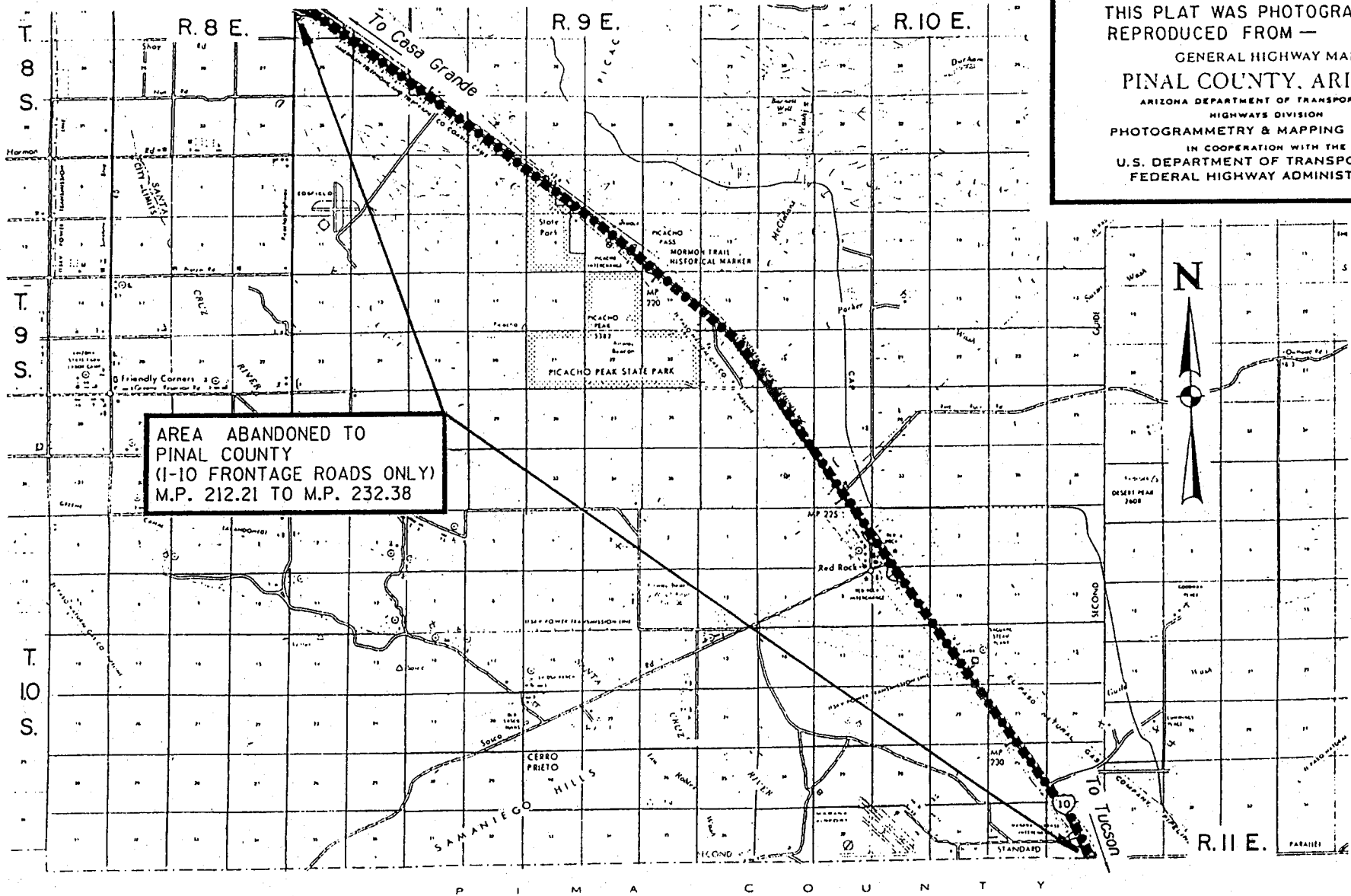
GENERAL HIGHWAY MAP

REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Intermodal Transportation Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the abandonment of a portion of the right of way acquired for State Route 84 within the above referenced project. This portion was previously established by various resolutions of record.

A portion of the previously acquired right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes. The Cities of Casa Grande, Eloy and Pinal County have agreed to accept jurisdiction of the right of way as it falls within their jurisdiction. Accordingly, I recommend that the State's interest in the portion of right of way be abandoned.

The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on the maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, CASA GRANDE - TUCSON Highway, Project 084PN177H088801R / 010PN232H088801R."

I further recommend that the portion of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" be removed from the State highway system and abandoned to the Cities of Casa Grande, Eloy and Pinal County as it falls within their jurisdiction.




