RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

VICTOR M. MENDEZ, Director, Arizona Department of Transportation, on September 19, 2003, presented and filed with this Transportation Board his written report under Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7046, recommending the abandonment of a portion of State Route 89A within the above referenced project.

The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, PRESCOTT - FLAGSTAFF Highway, Project S-366-605 & S-366-708 / 089ACN374H088801R."

WHEREAS said portion of right of way is no longer needed for State highway purposes; and

WHEREAS this Board finds that public safety, necessity and convenience will be served by accepting the Director's report; therefore, be it

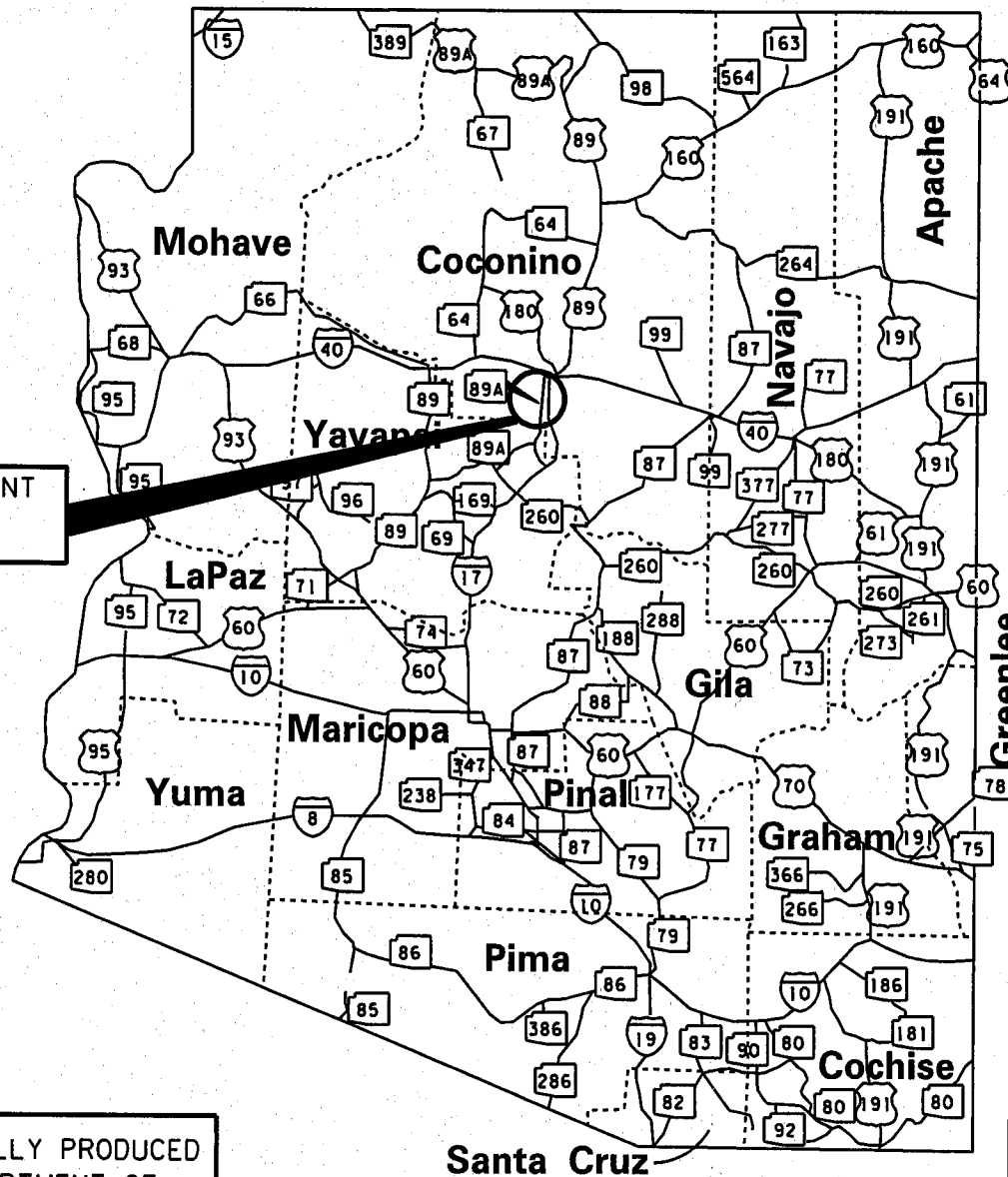
RESOLVED that the recommendation of the Director is adopted and made part of this resolution; be it further

RESOLVED that the portion of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" is hereby removed from the State Highway System and abandoned to the City of Sedona in Accordance with JPA 02-132, dated December 23, 2002 and Amendment #1, dated June 13, 2003 as provided in Arizona Revised Statute Section 28-7207 and 28-7209, and effective upon recordation in the Office of the County Recorder in accordance with Arizona Revised Statute Section 28-7213; be it further

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RESOLVED that the Director provide written notice to the City of Sedona evidencing the abandonment of the State's interest.

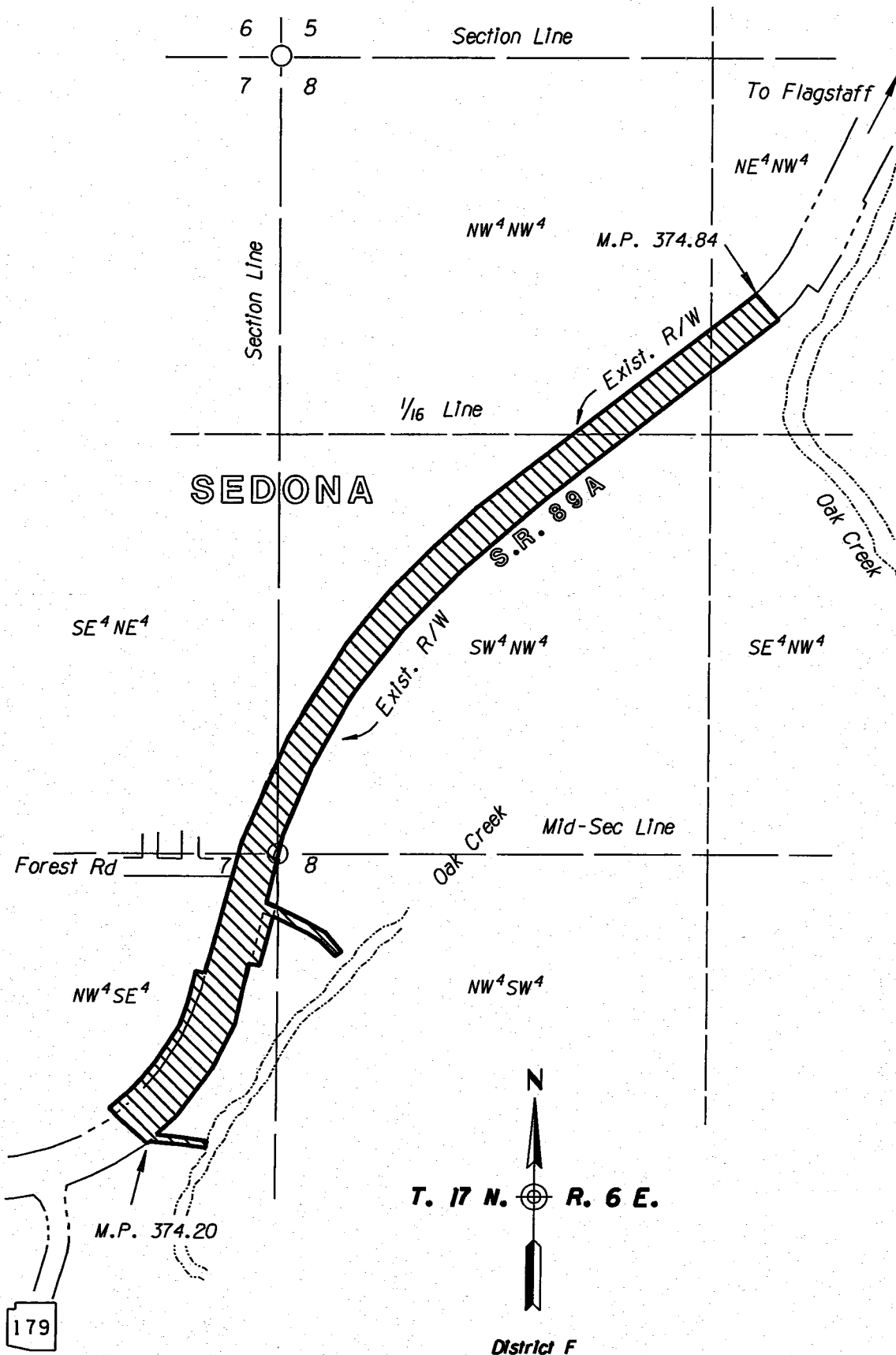

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REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Intermodal Transportation Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the abandonment of a portion of right of way acquired for State Route 89A within the above referenced project.

This portion was previously established by Arizona Highway Commission Resolution dated September 9, 1927, page 26 in the Official Minutes as a state route designated State Route 79; Resolution dated June 28, 1935 in the Official Minutes, pages 312 & 313, designated State Route 79 as a state highway; Resolution dated July 22, 1936 in the Official Minutes, page 5, redesignated and renumbered S.R. Route 79 to alternate U.S. Route 89; thereafter Arizona Transportation Board Resolution 76-14-A-042, dated August 20, 1976, established additional right of way for improvements; and Resolution 93-02-A-008, dated March 19, 1993, redesignated and renumbered U.S. Route 89A to State Route 89A.

A portion of the previously acquired right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes. The City of Sedona in Accordance with JPA 02-132 dated December 23, 2002 and amendment #1, dated June 13, 2003 has agreed to accept jurisdiction of the right of way. Accordingly, I recommend that the State's interest in the portion of right of way be abandoned.

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
The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on the maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, PRESCOTT - FLAGSTAFF Highway, Project S-366-605 & S-366-708 / 089ACN374H088801R."

I further recommend that the portion of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" be removed from the State Highway System and abandoned to the City of Sedona.

All other rights of way and easements and appurtenances thereto subject to the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7210 shall continue as they existed prior to the disposal of right of way depicted in Appendix "A".

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7046, I recommend that the Transportation Board adopt a resolution making this recommendation effective.


