RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

VICTOR M. MENDEZ, Director, Arizona Department of Transportation, on March 19, 2004, presented and filed with this Transportation Board his written report under Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7046, recommending the abandonment of a portion of State Route B-19 within the above referenced project.

The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, TUCSON - NOGALES Highway, Project F.A.86-A/F.I.86/I-19-1(12)43/019BPM043H088801R."

WHEREAS said portion of right of way is no longer needed for State transportation purposes; and

WHEREAS this Board finds that public safety, necessity and convenience will be served by accepting the Director's report; therefore, be it

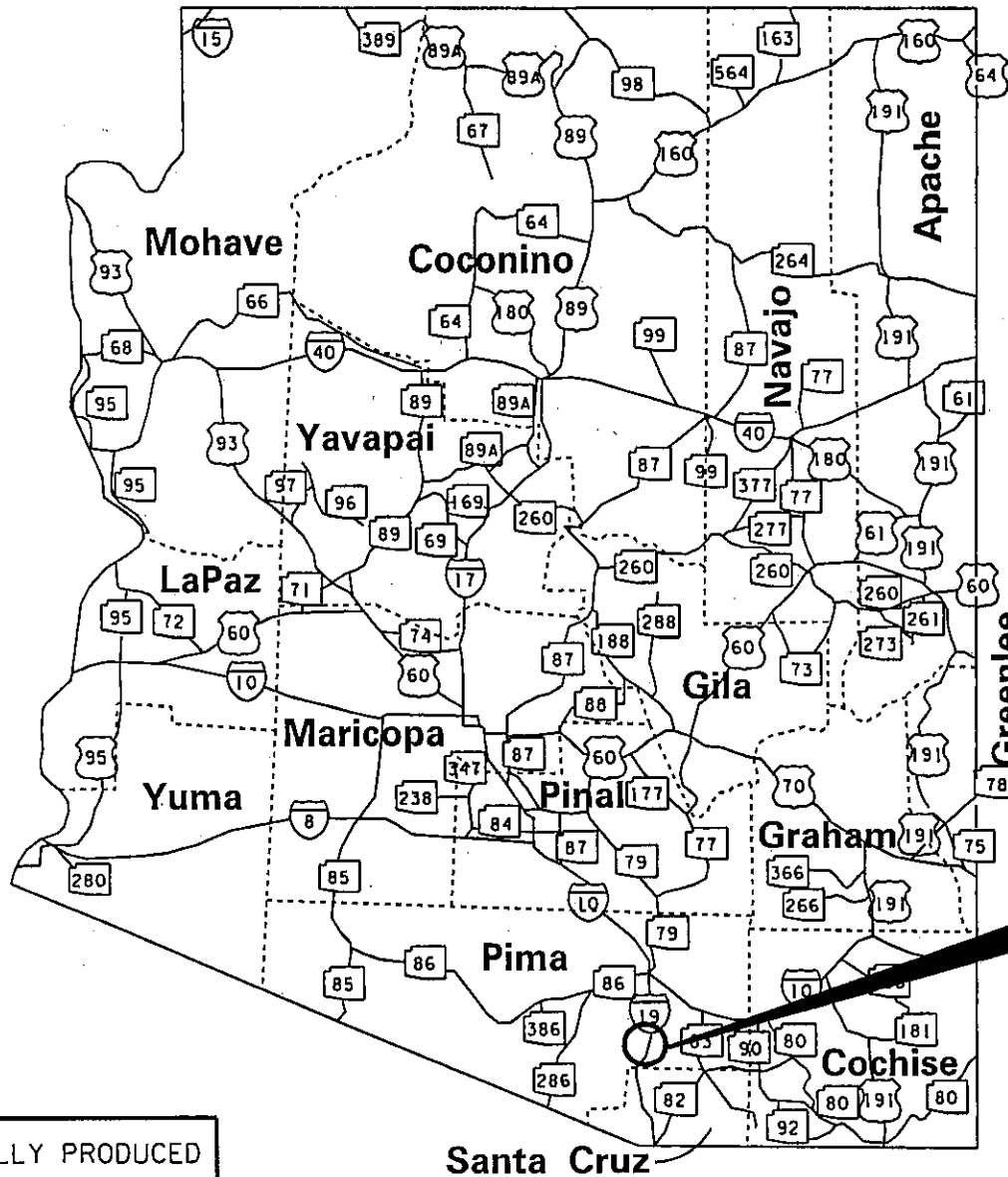
RESOLVED that the recommendation of the Director is adopted and made part of this resolution; be it further

RESOLVED that the portion of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" is hereby removed from the State Highway System and abandoned to Pima County and the Town of Sahuarita as provided in Arizona Revised Statute Sections 28-7207 and 28-7209, and effective upon recordation in the Office of the County Recorder in accordance with Arizona Revised Statute Section 28-7213; be it further

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RESOLVED that the Director provide written notice to Pima County and the Town of Sahuarita evidencing the abandonment of the State's interest in accordance with Intergovernmental Agreements 97-182 dated September 22, 1999, and 00-16 dated February 19, 2003, both filed with the Secretary of State.

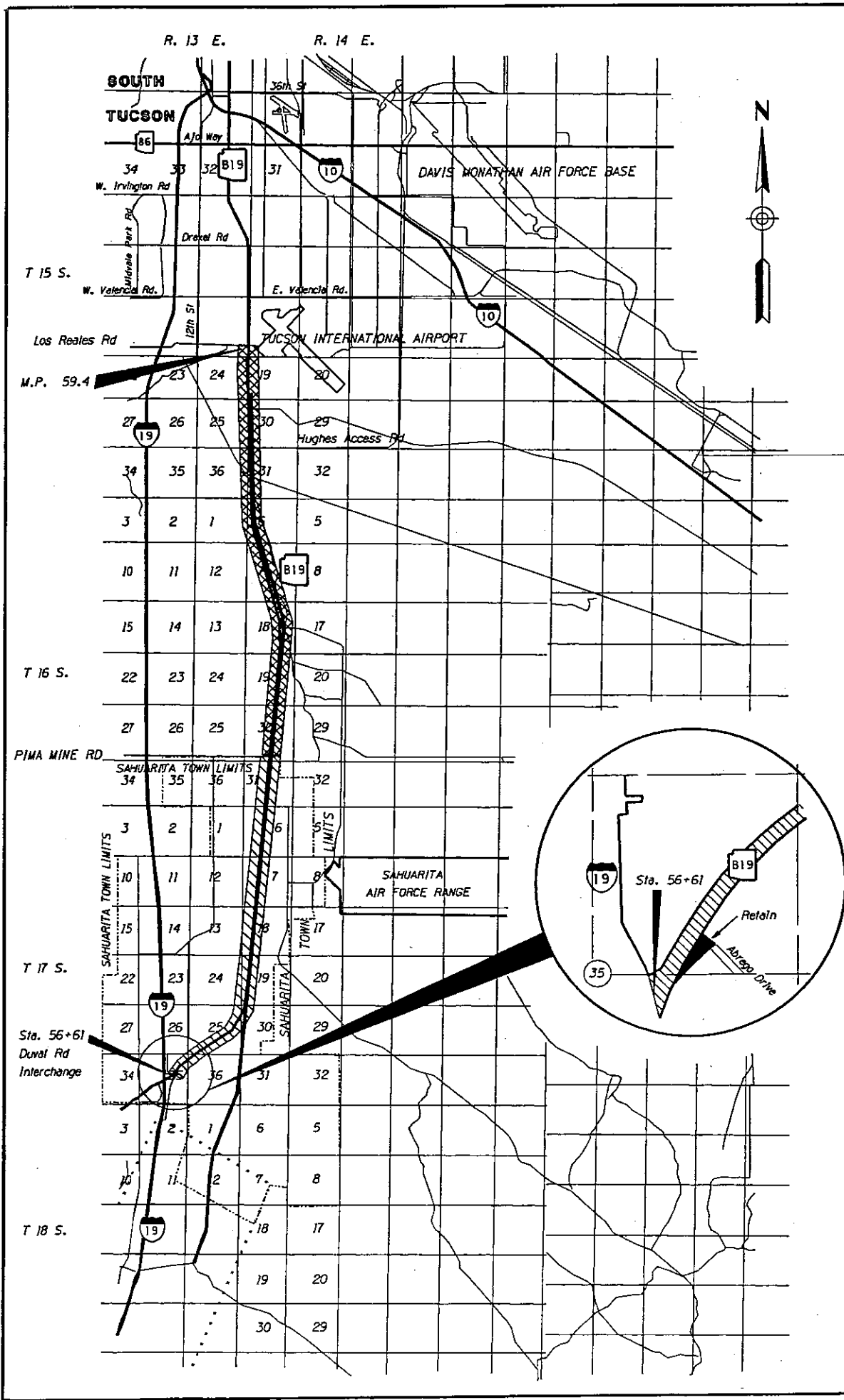

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REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Intermodal Transportation Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the abandonment of a portion of right of way acquired for State Route B-19 within the above referenced project.

This portion was previously established as a state route and state highway designated U.S. Route 89 on September 9, 1927, of the Official Minutes, page 26; various Resolutions authorized improvements thereto, and subsequently Arizona Transportation Board Resolution 92-08-A-56, dated August 21, 1992, renumbered U.S. Route 89 to S.R. B-19.

A portion of the previously acquired right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes. Pima County and the Town of Sahuarita have agreed to accept jurisdiction of the right of way in accordance with Intergovernmental Agreements 97-182 dated September 22, 1999, and 00-16 dated February 19, 2003, both filed with the Secretary of State. Accordingly, I recommend that the State's interest in the portion of right of way be abandoned.

The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on the maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, TUCSON - NOGALES Highway, Project F.A.86-A/F.I.86/I-19-1(12)43/019BPM043H088801R."

I further recommend that the portion of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" be removed from the State Highway System and abandoned to Pima County and the Town of Sahuarita.


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All other rights of way and easements and appurtenances thereto subject to the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7210 shall continue as they existed prior to the disposal of right of way depicted in Appendix "A".

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7046, I recommend that the Transportation Board adopt a resolution making this recommendation effective.


