WHEREAS this Board finds that public safety, necessity and convenience will be served by accepting the Director's report; therefore, be it





## APPENDIX "A"

That portion of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 2, Township 1 North, Range 5 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Maricopa County, Arizona, described as follows:

Commencing at a  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch rebar in pothole marking the North quarter corner of said Section 2, being North  $0^{\circ}11'12''$  East 2824.30 feet from a 4 inch Maricopa County aluminum cap marking the Center of said Section 2;

thence along the North – South mid section line of said Section 2, South  $0^{\circ}11'12''$  West 428.05 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING on the existing South right of way line of State Route 202 (RED MOUNTAIN FREEWAY);

thence along said existing South right of way line, South  $89^{\circ}43'00''$  East 80.30 feet to a point on the westerly line of that certain parcel according to Instrument No. 2004-1295777, records of Maricopa County, Arizona;

thence along said westerly line, South  $0^{\circ}11'12''$  West 79.78 feet;

thence continuing along said westerly line, South  $45^{\circ}22'37''$  West 66.67 feet;

thence North  $89^{\circ}48'48''$  West 78.00 feet;

thence North  $0^{\circ}11'12''$  East 126.98 feet to said existing South right of way line of State Route 202;

thence along said existing South right of way line, South  $89^{\circ}43'00''$  East 45.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Intermodal Transportation Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the abandonment of a portion of right of way acquired for State Route 202 Loop within the above referenced project.

This portion was previously established as a state route designated State Route 216 by Arizona Department of Transportation Board Resolution 85-04-A-32, dated April 26, 1985; Resolution 87-11-A-105, dated December 18, 1987 redesignated State Route 216 to State Route 202 Loop; Resolution 88-12-A-115, dated December 16, 1988 authorized advance acquisition and refined a portion of the State Route Plan; Resolution 2000-02-A-011, dated February 18, 2000 established State Route 202 Loop as a state highway; Resolution 2000-06-A-055, dated June 9, 2000 amended Resolution 2000-02-A-011 due to a design change.

A portion of the previously acquired right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes. The City of Mesa has agreed to accept jurisdiction of the right of way and has waived the Advance Four-Year Notice of Abandonment and Pavement Quality Report in accordance with the Arizona revised Statutes Section 28-7209, which will allow Arizona Department of Transportation to abandon right of way for a continued public use. Accordingly, I recommend that the State's interest in the portion of right of way be abandoned.

The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on the maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, RED MOUNTAIN FREEWAY, Project 600-8-802 / 202LMA013H492101R."

I further recommend that the portion of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" be removed from the State Highway System and abandoned to The City of Mesa for a public transportation use.

All other rights of way and easements and appurtenances thereto subject to the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7210 shall continue, as they existed prior to the disposal of right of way depicted in Appendix "A".

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7046, I recommend that the Transportation Board adopt a resolution making this recommendation effective.
