





REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Intermodal Transportation Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the abandonment of a portion of right of way acquired for U.S Route 95 within the above referenced project.

This portion was previously established as a State Route by Arizona Highway Commission Resolution dated May 19th, and 20th, 1936, pages 586 and 624 of the Official Minutes; Resolution dated May 26, 1936, page 634 of the Official Minutes established this route as a State Highway; Resolutions dated October 25, 1946, page 43 and August 1, 1947, page 208 relocated and altered a portion thereof; thereafter Arizona Department of Transportation Board Resolution 98-05-A-014, dated May 15, 1998, established additional right of way for improvements thereof.

A portion of the previously acquired right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes. The City of San Luis has agreed to accept jurisdiction of the right of way for a continued public transportation use by waiving the Advance Four-Year Notice of Abandonment and pavement quality report in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7209. Accordingly, I recommend that the State's interest in the portion of right of way be abandoned.

The portion of right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on the maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, SAN LUIS - YUMA - QUARTZSITE Highway, Project F-063-1-724 / 095YU.667H441601R."
